

William Carpenter and Emily Cox married, 21 July 1835,
at St. Martin's-in-the-Fields.

11 July 1836 — Girl born, 15 minutes before 12 P.M. died 15 July,
and buried 17 July, at Christchurch, Surrey.

—
23 June 1838 — Emily Eliza, born, half-past 12 ^[Noon] A.M. Christened,
July 15, at St. Andrew's Holborn, [On registering in the Parish
books, a blot was, caused by the clerk having erroneously entered
the date of birth as 20 June, which he corrected to 23 June.
She was not registered by the Registrar of Births & Deaths.]

—
2 June 1840 — William James, born 5 o'clock A.M.
registered 9th June, at office in Hunter-street, Brunswick Square
and was not christened. Died 20 February 1841, of Scarlet
Fever, and buried 22 February, in St. Andrew's ground,
Cray-i-Inn-Lane, Lower Ground, left-hand side of Foot-path.

—
26 April 1842 — Alfred William, born, 7 o'clock Evening
Registered, May 5, at Office in Hunter-street; christened,
August 7th, at Trinity Church, Cray-i-Inn-Lane.
Died 6 March 1846 in St John's Nursing Home

—
21 May 1844 — Frederick, born half-past 10 P.M.
Registered, June 26, at Camden Town District Office
(12, Union Terrace, Hampstead Road). Christened,
16 July 1848, at the Old Church of St. Pancras.

[See Remarks appended to the next entry.]
This boy was accidentally killed, by being jammed between a cart wheel and
gate post, at the bottom of College-street, Camden Town, on the 17th April
1849. Inquest held on the 20th, verdict "Death from Fracture of the Scull".
Buried, April 24, at the Old Ground, St. Pancras, front of head stone
to Maurice Margarot, left hand side of pathway.
